



# FOUNDATION STAGE

The Lady Sobell Nursery is a 60 placement orthodox Jewish nursery housed within a purpose built Early Years Foundation Stage Block, opened in 2008.

The school provides an enriched Early Years Curriculum. The learning opportunities that integrated Jewish and secular studies brings ensures that each child enjoys their learning experience.

The curriculum for the Early Years Foundation Stage underpins all further learning which in turn prepares them for their learning journey throughout the school.

### **Timings of the day**

#### **Morning (8.45-11.45)**

We offer part time funding for 15 hours per child, 5 mornings.

#### **Afternoon (11.45-15.20)**

We also offer the option for all children to continue their learning privately funded in the same setting and with the same staff. There is an option to stay to 4.00 within the Nursery environment.

The afternoon session will begin with the option to purchase a hot, fresh meal, prepared on site followed by a continuous early years curriculum.

We want them to enjoy their learning and be proud of who they are and have a love for their religion and culture. Children leave our setting to move onto Reception and to our main school with an established, solid foundation on which they can build.
