Annual Jewish Studies Curriculum Overview

The curriculum is designed to consolidate and extend the skills and knowledge acquired in earlier years in a more formal and text-based format. Pupils are expected to show commitment to regular homework and reading practise.

JEWISH LIVING/ JEWISH KNOWLEDGE	<p>This topic will be taught in mixed ability classes. In Year 5, all aspects of the Chagim, Jewish calendar and practice will be explored using a wide range of resources. Pupils will be expected to commit a considerable amount to memory. Lessons will be differentiated and support given where necessary. The classes will be taught using the Etgar textbook. The Chaggim Curricula will be followed for each of the festivals throughout the year.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. General Knowledge/Tefillah (looking particularly at the Amidah)/aspects of Shabbat. 2. Jewish general knowledge – regular self-study and testing on the expected knowledge-base throughout the year. <p>Assessment: Written test papers / question and answer / samples of formal work/quizzes,/discussions</p>		
IVRIT	<p>Throughout the year, pupils will build on their previous knowledge of Ivrit using Ivrit B'click and Sinai's Ivrit Programme of Study. In addition, Ivrit is used informally across the curriculum in a variety of situations.</p> <p>Assessment: Sampling of formal work / Cross curricular assessment / Vocabulary homework.</p>		
READING	<p>Emphasis is placed on the necessity for a commitment to maintain and extend fluency in reading and script writing throughout the year. Pupils are expected to undertake regular weekly reading practice, and to pay attention to the accuracy of their spelling and letter formation, to attain fluency and pace of writing. Specific Hebrew reading targets have been given to pupils and their reading is continuously assessed.</p> <p>Assessment: Regular individual and group assessment/target sheets</p>		
NEVI'IM	<p>Pupils will learn the chronology of what happened to Bnei Yisrael once they entered Eretz Yisrael and study the lives of Yehoshua, Devorah, Gidon, Ehud, Eglon and Ruth.</p> <p>Assessment: Formal written work, discussions, role play, quizzes, target sheets, ICT sessions and work produced by pupils.</p>		
TORAH	<p>They will use the JCP's curriculum to continue to build upon the skills and knowledge they have learnt from Year 2 onwards. They will begin by learning Unit 5 of the JCP Chumash Curriculum. They will also learn Units 6 and 7. The children will be taught in mixed-ability groups for Chumash. I pads will be used when appropriate.</p> <p>In addition, pupils will learn a selection of important lessons from the weekly parasha. They will be given a Daf Hashavuah sheet each Friday which should be read out with the family and discussed. The questions must be completed and the sheet returned every Monday.</p> <p>Assessment: Regular testing / quizzes / discussions / samples of formal written work/target sheets/JCP assessments</p>
