

Behaviour and Exclusions Policy - Addendum during Covid – 19 response

When returning to school on 1st June children, parent/carers must complete the Covid-19 Home School Agreement.

Behaviour expectations

In class children will be reminded of the behaviour expectations in school and the school rules. These rules will be clearly displayed in each room and referred to regularly so that children and parents know what is expected at all times.

The children will also be taught:

- The importance of social distancing and what this means in their setting; in the classroom, when using equipment, in corridors, outside in the playground, and when going to the toilet.
- How to wash their hands with soap and water effectively for at least 20 seconds, and will be reminded to do so frequently throughout the day
- How to 'catch it' (cover your nose and mouth with a clean tissue when you cough or sneeze), 'bin it' (dispose of used tissue in nearest bin) when coughing or sneezing
- To tell an adult if they are feeling unwell
- Not to bring things in from home (except those stated by the school; stationary, drink and snack, or packed lunch for Yr6 only), or take things home from school that would need to be returned.

PSHCE

From the 1st of June there will be increased PSHE lessons to support the children returning to school.

COVID-19-related incidents

All staff will be vigilant of any pupils who wilfully refuse to adhere to arrangements of social distancing and deliberately cough or spit at pupils or staff, putting them at risk.

A member of the SLT will be informed immediately if any such incident takes place. The Head Teacher will make an informed decision regarding appropriate sanctions, up to and including exclusion.
